APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Rebates are available to Danvers' Residential Electric Account holders with active accounts in good standing. If account is not active or in good standing, the rebate will not be processed.
- Application requires the proof of purchase with a clear line item with **model numbers** displaying the products purchased in the form of the sales receipt dated on or after January 1, 2011, a **completed and signed** Rebate Application, and a copy of the yellow **Energy Guide label**. If an application is submitted incomplete, it will be returned to the applicant.
- Only **electric** heat pumps are eligible for rebate. Natural gas models do not qualify. For combination units (heat pump/AC) only the heat pump rebate will be issued. **AHRI Certificate** must be provided by installer.
- Offer limited to **TWO ENERGYSTAR** appliance purchases per customer account, per calendar year on a first-come, first-served basis, effective until the funding is exhausted or the program is discontinued.
- New construction projects (any construction after January 2008) or home additions do not qualify for rebates since all usage in new construction or additions is considered an additional draw on Danvers' energy use. **Rebates are for remodeling only.**
- Fixtures must be **replacing** existing fixtures and installed at the account location. Old fixtures cannot be reused by applicant or other Danvers residents.
- Danvers Electric Division reserves the right to inspect the installation on premises.
- Applicant agrees and understands that the Danvers Electric Division does not guarantee that the installation of an EnergyStar rated fixture will result in energy savings, as site-specific energy consumption varies.
- Danvers Electric Division does not warrant, endorse or assume liability for the quality, performance or safety of the contractor and/or retailer or wholesaler or performance of any appliance or fixture. Responsibility for product chosen is solely the applicant's.
- Individual rebates more than \$600 may require the issuance of a 1099 Tax Form.

- * Rebate processing will take **8-10 weeks** from the receipt of a **completed** application. Rebate checks will be sent upon application review, processing and approval.
