Trash and Recycling Program—Upcoming Changes

With the current collection contract set to expire on June 30, 2023, the Town went through a competitive procurement process with multiple regional vendors and selected **Republic Services** who purchased JRM (the Town's prior hauler) in the Spring of 2022. In September 2023, the Town of Danvers will be transitioning to a new trash/recycling collection program. Residents serviced by the Town's collection program will be notified of all changes prior to the program roll out. These changes will include the following:

- Standardized carts will be delivered to residents at no cost including a 96-gallon recycling cart and a 64-gallon trash cart. Additional refuse carts will be made available for purchase.
- The hauler will be transitioning to automated collection vs manual collection.
- The Town will be returning to every other week collection of recycling. **Residents will be informed of which week their recycling will be collected prior to this change.**
- The town will continue to support a Bulky Item Collection sticker program.
- Leaf and yard waste collection will remain the same.
- Drop off at the Transfer Station will still be available.

More details will be provided to residents the closer we get to the September rollout.
